Fundamental rules

NOTE - Entrants are requested to read carefully the following rules, under which conditions, entries only are accepted.

1. The council reserves the right to amalgamate or cancel any class in which sufficient entries are not received. The judges shall not award a prize unless there is sufficient merit, and no second prize will be awarded unless there are three or more entries, the property of different owners.
2. Entry forms to be accurately filled up in every particular must be lodged together with the full amount of entry fees on or before the 25th of July. Any willful misinformation on an entry form will lead to disqualification. Phone entries are not accepted.
3. Printed numbers will be available for collection at the secretary's tent on the morning of the show. All exhibits must be on the grounds at 09:30 a.m. only two persons will be admitted per animal.
4. Any objection to an award of the judges must be lodged with the secretaries within 1 hour of the judges giving their decision, and in jumping competitions, within fifteen minutes after the award has been made. Each objection to be made in writing, fully stating the reason, and must be accompanied by a fee of €50, which may be returned if the objection is sustained.
5. No person shall enter the space enclosed for the adjudication or hold any communication with the judges or stewards, and no person shall act as judge or steward in a ring who is an exhibitor in any one of the classes under adjudication in that ring.
6. Entrants are to understand that, although reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure the safety and welfare of the exhibits, the council will not be responsible for accidents or loss of any kind in connection with the show. All exhibits are entered entirely at owners' risk.
7. The council delegates full powers to the stewards to enforce all the foregoing regulations.

10. The committee reserves the right to decline any entry and return the fee, without being liable to any claim for compensation.
12. To determine the highest number of points in any section, the following scale shall be used: first prize counts 4 points; second prize 3 points; third prize 2 points; and reserve 1 point.
13. The committee reserves the right to contact exhibitors. Contact the office directly to opt out of this agreement.
14. Cup winners shall, at the time of receiving the trophies, sign a receipt for the same and an undertaking to return those not won outright, in a clean condition, to the society, at least two weeks before the date at which they are offered for further competition.
16. Prize money will be paid to all winning competitors on show day. Exhibitors of animals will receive their winnings at the same time that they receive their rosette.
17. The show committee will not in any way be responsible should any accident occur to any person attending the show or for any loss or damage to cars, vehicles or their content.

DISCIPLINE:

THE **IRISH SHOWS ASSOCIATION** EXPECTS AND WILL INSIST UPON APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR FROM ALL EXHIBITORS AND OTHERS PARTICIPATING IN ANY OF THE ACTIVITIES AT OUR MEMBER SHOWS AND WILL NOT TOLERATE INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR.

Inappropriate behavior shall include, but not be limited to, the following: PROFANITY, COARSE OR VULGAR LANGUAGE OR GESTURES TOWARDS JUDGES, EXHIBITORS OR OTHER SHOW OFFICIALS

Harassment or bullying, including using words or actions that threaten, intimidate or undermine judges or other officials before, during or following Member Show activities

Failure to follow rules and/or obey instructions

Abusing any animal

Disciplinary Procedures:

Complaints of misconduct against an exhibitor or other participant at a Member Show shall be investigated and adjudicated upon by a subcommittee appointed by the Irish Shows Association. The said subcommittee shall consist of three members of the board of the Irish Shows Association and shall be known as the Disciplinary Committee. The disciplinary Committee shall seek to ensure the existence of accordance with natural and constitutional justice. For further details refer to www.irishshows.org

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ANIMAL OWNERS INVOLVED IN SHOWING ANIMALS:

The Irish Shows Association would advise ALL animal owners to have Insurance cover for their animals; this should include cover whilst showing animals at shows. We understand that it costs very little or nothing depending on whom you have insurance cover with.

This advice is to protect yourself in the event of your animal causing injury or damage to a person or person's property, and if it's established that your animal was out of control at that time, you may be held responsible, or partly responsible for the injury or damage.

Equine

Classes with three or less entries will be amalgamated.

All horses shall be subject to the opinion of a V.S; if required, and all animals entered in classes where height is a qualification. Certificate from a veterinary surgeon must be produced to the senior steward. Certificates can be obtained free of charge from an official veterinary surgeon in the show grounds.

In all horse and cattle classes 5% will be deducted from prize money for the I.S.A. Championship Fund.

Horse classes begin judging at 10.00 am sharp for Young stock, followed by Brood Mares and Foals.

SAFETY:

Horse riding is a dangerous sport. All competitors in Ridden Classes are strongly advised, for their own safety, to wear appropriate headgear that complies with up to date safety standards.

1. For two-year-old Traditionally Bred Fillies, suitable for producing High Quality Traditionally Bred Sport Horses.
2. Fillies must have been registered as foals with a society that maintains its breed for - the Irish Sport Horse Breed, the Irish Draught Breed, the Thoroughbred Breed & the Connemara Pony Breed and MUST be APPROVED by: Thoroughbred Stallions, Connemara Stallions, ISH (TIH) Stallions, Irish Draught Stallions or Any cross of the aforementioned
3. Dams of the fillies must be by the Stallions as above and registered with a society that maintains its breed.
4. NA 1 Irish Sport Horse Stallions or similar classification.
5. All exhibitors must have their fillies passports available for inspection

at the Qualifying show and at the Championship

6. Entry fee for the Qualifier is €15, Entry fee for the Championship is €25.
7. More than one filly may be selected at any qualifying show, provided that the standard of entries warrants such selection.
8. Should the standard of entries be insufficient, no filly will be selected.
9. Infringement of these conditions or Championship regulations may lead to disqualification.

RULES AND CONDITIONS**

1. The aim of this championship is to encourage the breeding of Irish Draught Foals.
2. The Championship is open to all foals eligible for ID Class 1 status.
3. A Maximum of Two exhibits may qualify, provided the judges feel the standard is high enough for an ISA Championship.
4. The Dams passport must be produced for inspection at the qualifying rounds and at the final.
5. The foals' passport must be produced at the final.
6. One of the judges at the qualifying shows to be from the Irish Draught Horse Judges list if possible.
7. Foals competing at the final are ineligible to enter any other class at Bantry Show.
8. There will be separate classes for colt foals and filly foals at the final.
9. The overall Champion will be selected from the winners of each class.
10. The Qualifying Exhibitor must fill out their own Qualifying Card at each Qualifying Show. Completed card and entry fee must be handed into the secretary's office on show day.

These rules should be read in conjunction with the I.S.A Rules.

**Class 13. THE IRISH DRAUGHT FILLY FOAL CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER
RULES AND CONDITIONS:**

1. This competition is open to animals, with the breed code ID, registered in The Irish Draught Horse Studbook (or a harmonised Irish Draught Studbook) with recorded breeding.
2. If the foal's passport is not to hand, the mare's passport must be ready for inspection prior to entry to the judging ring. Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification.
3. Foals must be led at all times.
4. Passports & (Microchips if applicable) should be read by a Vet at the Final.
5. A Maximum of Two exhibits may qualify, provided the judges feel the standard is high enough for an ISA Championship.
6. One of the judges at the qualifying show must be from the I D H Judges List.
7. Foals qualified for the final are not eligible to enter any other class at the show where the final is held.

8. The Qualifying Exhibitor must fill out their own Qualifying Card at each Qualifying Show. Completed card and entry fee must be handed into the secretary's office on show day.

A prize will be presented for Combination of Best Turned out Foal and Most Suitably Dressed Handler.

2. Exhibitors to both the qualifier & Final must have their animals' passport available for inspection prior to entry to Judging Ring. Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification.
3. Passports & Microchips should be read by a Vet at the Final
4. A Maximum of Two exhibits may qualify, provided the judges feel the standard is high enough for an ISA Championship.
5. One of the judges at the qualifying show must be a qualified Irish Draught Horse Judge.
6. Animals qualified for the final are not eligible to enter any other class at the show where the final is being held.
7. The Qualifying Exhibitor must fill out their own Qualifying Card at each Qualifying Show. Completed card and entry fee must be handed into the secretary's on show day.

These rules should be read in conjunction with the I.S.A Rules

IRISH PONY SOCIETY CO. LTD. CLASS SPECIFICATIONS & ABBREVIATIONS

All pony Classes at Shows affiliated to the I.P.S. shall be carried out & judged in accordance with the Society's Regulations, Rules & Bye-Laws.

- (a) NO RIDER UNDER 5 YEARS ON 1ST JANUARY OF CURRENT YEAR MAY COMPETE IN ANY CLASS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE LEAD REIN CLASSES FOR WHICH THE MINIMUM AGE IS 3 YEARS ON 1ST JANUARY OF CURRENT YEAR
- (b) NO CHANGE OF TACK IS PERMITTED IN ANY CLASS
- (c) "SNAFFLE" BIT MEANS A SINGLE RINGED SNAFFLE

Temporary Registration: Ponies which are registered on a temporary basis will not be eligible for qualifying points for the R.D.S. or annual awards, etc. but points won will be recorded for the purpose of determining status.

POINTS SYSTEM:

Restricted Open & Novice Classes: 1st - 4 points; 2nd - 3 points; 3rd - 2 points; 4th - 1 point. Intermediate & Open Classes: 1st - 6 points; 2nd - 5 points; 3rd - 4 points; 4th - 3 points.

Higher points will be awarded at selected major affiliated Shows as decided by the I.P.S. Council from time to time.

When a pony has gained a total of 50 points, he will then be deemed to be open, points to be calculated at the last date of entry for the Show. No points awarded in Special or unaffiliated Classes such as Local, Pony Club or Family Pony. Every owner is responsible for keeping a record of the points earned by their animal for the purpose of determining its status, & in order to ensure that it is not entered in, & does not compete in, any competition for which it is ineligible.

SHOW PONY RIDING SECTION

NOVICE SHOW PONY RIDING CLASSES are open to:

- a) PONIES THAT HAVE NOT ATTAINED 50 POINTS IN *SHOW PONY RIDING CLASSES AT SHOWS AFFILIATED TO THE IRISH PONY SOCIETY, INCLUDING IRISH PONY SOCIETY SHOWS.
- b) PONIES THAT HAVE NOT WON AN OPEN SHOW PONY RIDING CLASS IN ANY COUNTRY OTHER THAN IRELAND NOR COMPLETED IN AN INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION WITH THE EXCEPTION OF A PONY EXPRESSLY SELECTED BY THE I.P.S. FOR SUCH A COMPETITION.
- c) (I) PONIES THAT HAVE NOT WON A MAJOR OPEN SHOW PONY RIDING CHAMPIONSHIP NOT AFFILIATED TO THE IRISH PONY SOCIETY.

(ii) Ponies that have not qualified at a Show not affiliated to the Irish Pony Society for a major Open Show Pony Riding Championship to be held in Ireland or overseas.

Riding Classes are those Show Pony Riding Classes for which both Novice & Open

Classifications are currently included in the list of I.P.S. specifications.

The Council reserves the right to cancel any Pony Classes in which there are less than 4 entries. All prize money must be collected prior to leaving the ring.

Entries will not be accepted on the field or over the phone – no exceptions

Class 34. OPEN SHOW STARTER STAKES

For ponies, mares or Geldings, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 133cms,

suitable for & to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 12th birthday on 1st January of current year.

Class 35. OPEN 123CMS. SHOW HUNTER PONY

Confined to ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 123cms. Suitable for & to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 11th birthday on 1st January of current year.

Class 36. OPEN 133CMS. SHOW HUNTER PONY

Confined to ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 133cms. Suitable for & to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 11th birthday on 1st January of current year

Class 37. OPEN 143CMS. SHOW HUNTER PONY

Confined to ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 143cms. Suitable for & to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 11th birthday on 1st January of current year

Class 38. OPEN 153CMS. SHOW HUNTER PONY

Confined to ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 153cms. Suitable for & to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 11th birthday on 1st January of current year

Class 39. OPEN INTERMEDIATE. SHOW HUNTER PONY

Confined to ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old & over. Over 148cm & not exceeding 158cms. Suitable for & to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 11th birthday on 1st January of current year

Class 40. OPEN MIXED HEIGHTS SHOW PONY

Confined to ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 148cms. Suitable for & to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 11th birthday on 1st January of current year

Class 41. OPEN RIDDEN CONNEMARA UNDER 16

4 years old & over, riders under 16 years on 1st January of current year.

Class 42. OPEN RIDDEN CONNEMARA OVER 16

4 years old & over, riders over 16 years on 1st January of current year.

Class 43. NOVICE RIDDEN CONNEMARA

Confined to ponies 4 years old, or 5, 6, 7, year old ponies that have not gained 50 points in Ridden Connemara.

Class 44. CHAMPION RIDDEN PONY

All 1st & second prize-winners in classes' 34-43 excluding class 39 eligible.

Class 45. INTERMEDIATE CHAMPIONSHIP

All 1st & 2nd prize-winners in classes' 35 & 55 eligible

For ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 123cms. Suitable for & to be ridden by riders of correct age.

Open to non-IPS members

Class 50. MINI WORKING HUNTER CHAMPION

1st & 2nd prize winners from class 47 to 49 eligible

Class 51. OPEN WORKING STARTER STAKES

For ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 133cms. Suitable for & to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 12th birthday on 1st January of current year.

Class 52. OPEN 133CMS. WORKING HUNTER PONY

For ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old & over, exceeding 123cms. Not exceeding 133cms. Suitable for & to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 14th birthday on 1st January of current year.

Class 53. OPEN 143CMS. WORKING HUNTER PONY

For ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old & over, exceeding 133cms. Not exceeding 143cms. Suitable for & to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 17th birthday on 1st January of current year.

Class 54. OPEN 153CMS. WORKING HUNTER PONY

For ponies, mares or geldings, 4 years old & over, exceeding 143cms. Not exceeding 153cms. Suitable for & to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 20th birthday on 1st January of current year.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS:

The following changes are being introduced for keepers of bovine animals who wish to show cattle - these changes apply from the 2014 show season.

Keepers of cattle are now required to obtain a Certificate of Compliance prior to the movement of an animal to a Show. Certificates of Compliance can be obtained online from the Animal Identification & Movement (AIM) system through the www.agfood.ie facility or from the Cattle Movement Notification Agency.

When applying for a Certificate of Compliance, keepers should not specify a destination herd.

On the day of the Show, the Certificate of Compliance should be presented to the Show Secretary along with the bovine passport for the animal.

The keeper & the Show Secretary will then sign the Movement Notification section of the Certificate which will then be sent to the local DVO for recording onto the AIM system.

Please note that only cattle for which a valid Certificate of Compliance is provided to the Show Secretary will be allowed to be shown on the day of the Show.

These Certificates will replace the previously-used CMMS 4 forms.

All sheep must be identified individually with appropriate ear tags issued in accordance with the requirements of the National Sheep Identification System (NSIS)

Movement Documentation

All consignments of sheep being moved must be accompanied by a completed dispatch document. Individual details of each sheep in the consignment must be recorded on the document. Sheep from non-restricted flocks only can be moved to Shows. In the case of flocks restricted following diagnosis of scrapie, sheep possessing the ARR/ARR genotype only may be exhibited. The movement of these ARR/ARR genotype sheep must be accompanied by the relevant movement permit (SCR /10) which can be obtained from the local District Veterinary Office in the county where the flock is located.

AIM Notification

The movement of sheep to & from an Agricultural Show within the State must be recorded on

AIM. This is done using a copy of the owner's sheep dispatch document as follows:

The owner/keeper presents the signed & completed dispatch document to the show secretary who checks it to ensure that it is completed in full. The show secretary fills in the MART section of the dispatch document with (i) the show number, (ii) the date of the move back to the source

holding (iii) stamps it with the show stamp & (iv) signs the dispatch document.

The show secretary then forwards the completed pink section of the dispatch document to the local DVO within 7 days of the show movement. The show secretary keeps the white copy for his/her records. The source/destination keeper keeps the bottom yellow copy to enter it into their flock register. Ultimate responsibility for fulfilling this requirement lies with the Show Secretary.
